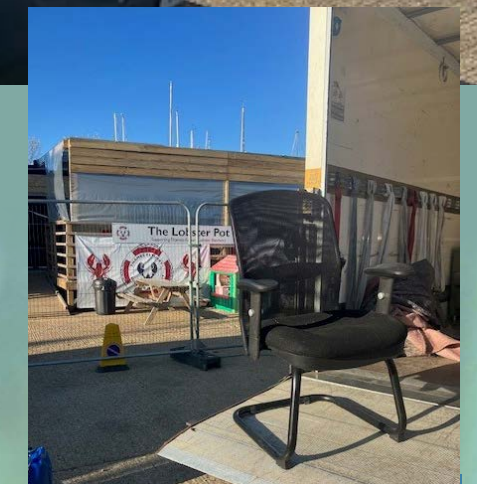
ReWORK Furniture Donated to Local Lobster Hatchery!

The Thames Estuary Lobster Hatchery's mission is to promote the importance of sustainability in fisheries and aquaculture through accessible education for all and Conservation.

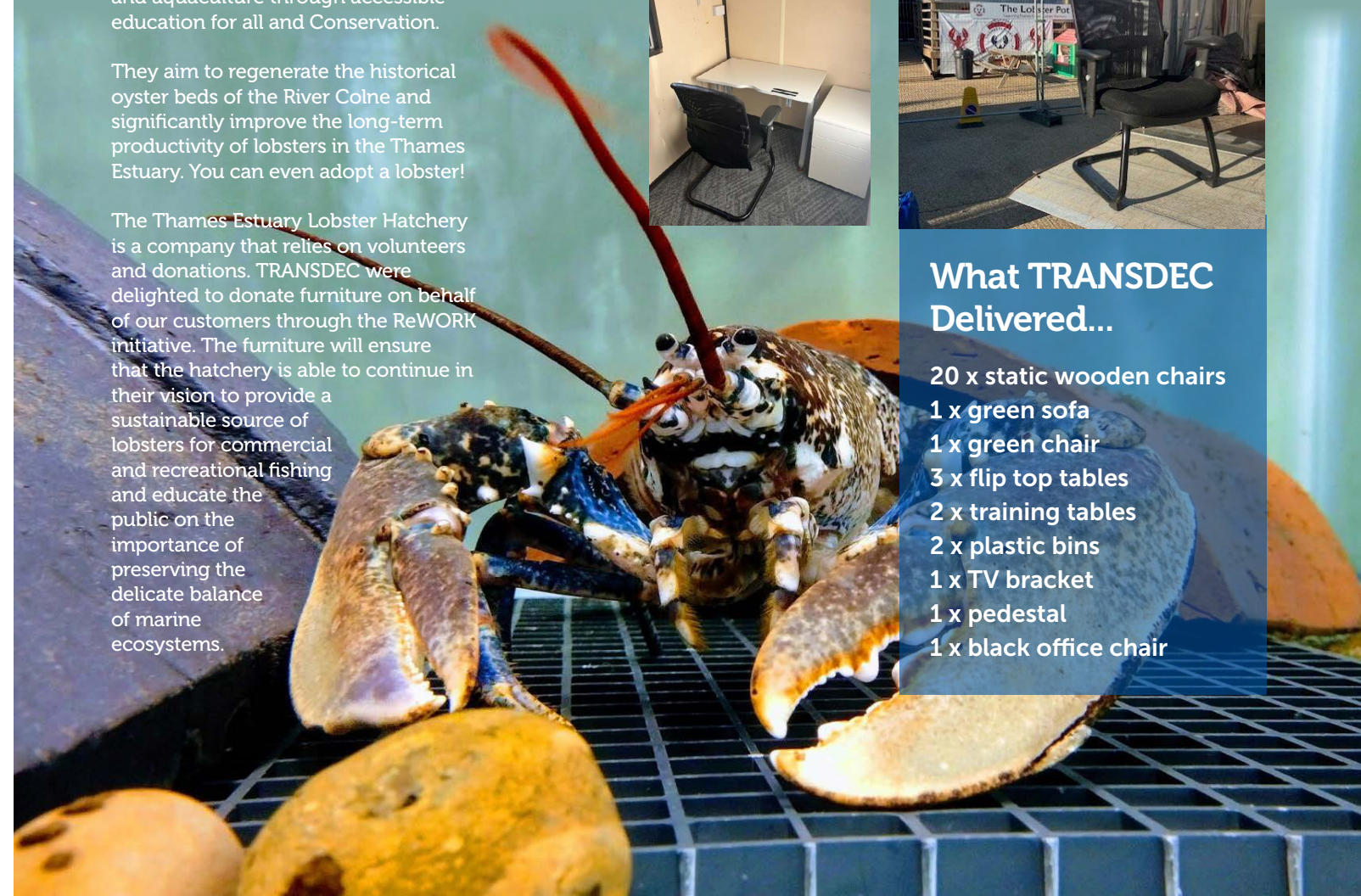
